## Unlocking IT Success For Libraries With E-Rate & Matrix Integration

### The Challenge

- **Limited Budgets:** Libraries tend to struggle to fund necessary IT upgrades and security within tight financial constraints.
- **Evolving Tech Needs:** Keeping up with rapidly changing IT demands can overwhelm resources.
- **Connectivity Issues:** Ensuring reliable internet access across multiple locations is a significant challenge, especially in underserved areas.

### The Solution

- **High-Speed Connectivity:** Main location has 2 GB internet; second location connected via 1 GB WAN.
- **Cost Reduction:** Total annual fee is \$51,480, E-Rate covers \$41,184, saving the library nearly 80%.
- **Efficient Spending:** Over 3 years, the library spends \$30,888, excluding VPN costs, thanks to E-Rate.
- **Cost-Effective Upgrades:** One-time firewall investment of \$13,470 with 3 years of service included.
- **Affordable Internet:** Spectrum fiber provides 1 GB of internet for both locations at \$80/month.
- **Long-Term Savings:** Total 3-year spend \$19,230, saving the library \$11,658, no additional VPN charges.
